The GCHS Shelter is proud of its 97%(+) adoption rate. Our job is to take in unwanted animals, but more importantly, it is to find them good, loving homes. Since our opening in 1997, we've found homes for over 97% of the animals that come to us. Most shelters struggle to achieve a 15% adoption rate; you can see why we are so proud of our success.



#### FOSTERING IS AN AWESOME WAY TO SAVE AN ANIMAL

Seguin has an amazing Animal Rescue Foundation that also needs volunteers.

Like GCHS, ARF-Texas is a 501C3 non-profit organization that also works in Guadalupe County, Texas. They promote animal welfare by reducing the euthanasia rates at local shelters through adopting,



fostering and rescuing animals. Each year they save approximately 300 dogs and cats. Unlike GCHS, they do not have a holding facility or shelter, and they depend solely on volunteers to foster the animals they rescue until they find a loving, forever home. As a foster, everything that a dog needs are covered by ARF. However, to be clear, some costs may be incurred by a foster.

ARF tries to provide food for all fosters, but sometimes there might not be enough food available. If you are interested in becoming a foster for ARF, please visit their website at <a href="www.arf-texas.org">www.arf-texas.org</a> Included in their website is a complete manual for foster families. Their volunteers work with the family in every way possible to ensure a good fit, and if the animal does not work out for some reason, they will find another family for the dog.

Speaking of VOLUNTEERS, GCHS always needs volunteers! We are a volunteer-run non-profit. We need volunteers to work at our front desk, help with the dogs and cats, and we really need help with our garage/rummage sales! To volunteer you must be at least 16 years old.
